One of my colleagues at Knutsford station, PC Blyth, has today been out in the village today (18/07/10) between 10:20 and 11:30am with the speed gun. He has stopped and verbally warned 11 drivers for travelling above 30mph but below 40mph. He has also issued a 12th driver a fixed penalty ticket for travelling at 45mph. The ticket is a fine of £60 and 3 points on their licence.

Also, on the 5th August, officers from Knutsford along with officers from Holmes Chapel fire station will be conducting a driver engagement day at the village hall in Chelford. Drivers will stopped for speeding, not wearing a seat belt and for using mobile phones. The driver will be given the option of having a ticket or having a presentation by the fire station, educating them about the very real dangers and consequences of speeding.
