

Hello All

This is the report for ASB (anti social behaviour) and crime for Chelford, Nether Alderley, Great Warford and Snelson beat area for January 2010.

### **ASB**

1 incident of ASB in February this month. This was a vehicle revving its engine loudly and causing a general nuisance on the Chelford village hall car park.

### **CRIME**

2 incidents on different dates of theft of number plates in Chelford, .

Vehicle broken into in Nether Alderley and tools stolen.

Damage to front door magnets at the Nat West bank in Chelford.

A drive off (not paying for fuel) at the Chelford Shell.

Theft of chickens and sheep at Dunvilles Farm on the A537 at Nether Alderley. More chickens have been stolen in March and one of the number plates stolen from Chelford earlier in February was found at the scene.

Attempt burglary in Snelson.

Cannabis seizure at Dixon Court in Chelford. 3 people arrested and still under investigation.

### **From PCSO Clare SHEPHERD (PCSO for Great Warford)**

The priority for February was speeding along Merryman's Lane, Mill Lane and Chelford road, the speed indicating device was placed along these roads to help reduce that.

Also foot patrol has been done by myself on Buttermere Drive, so that the residents have the opportunity to approach me with any issues that they have and also to offer reassurance.

I attended at Warford Park with the fire service to give advice on fire safety and crime prevention to the residents.
