 - 4 1 Lettuce
 - 5 5 Herbs in water
 - 6 5 Sweet Peas
 - 7 3 Roses of the same variety
 - 8 5 Different garden flowers in water with foliage
 - 9 Indoor pot plant grown for foliage
(not previously shown, owned for at least three months)
 - 10 Indoor flowering pot plant
(not previously shown, owned for at least three months)

Floral Art

- 11 Miniature arrangement not more than 4 inches (10 cms) overall
- 12 Summertime; an exhibit within the allotted area of 18 ins wide by 18 ins deep (45.7 cms x 45.7 cms). No height restriction.
- 13 An arrangement in a candlestick

Fresh flowers and foliage may be purchased for these classes

Cookery

- 14 5 chocolate éclairs filled
- 15 Victoria sandwich cake 7 inches (17.8 cms) in diameter
- 16 An Apple Pie (pastry top and bottom)
- 17 An individual Savoury Dish (no fish)
- 18 Strawberry Jam 1lb (454 gm) or 12 ozs (340 gm)
Date made to be on the jar
- 19 Lemon curd 8 ozs (227 gm); date made to be on the jar

Preserves must be in a clear plain glass jar, no trade names.

Preserves are best if they have a new twist top applied whilst the preserve is hot to give a good seal
